

## How to search the Aetna Network (pre-enrollment)

This document outlines how to check if your doctor participates in Aetna's network before you have elected your medical plan. If you are already enrolled in an Aetna plan and need to find in-network providers, please log onto your account at [aetna.com](https://www.aetna.com). If you have not already registered, use your SSN or Member ID number to locate your account.

**Step 1:** Navigate to the [Aetna's Directory of Health Care Professionals](#) and input your zip-code under "Guest". Set your search radius, then click Search

**Step 2:** Select a network:

- If you live in Vermont, Idaho, South Dakota, Missouri, or New Hampshire:
  - PPO or CDHP: Select **Open Choice PPO** under **Aetna Standard Plans**, then click **Continue**.
- If you live in California:
  - PPO or CDHP: Select **Managed Choice POS** under **Aetna Standard Plans**, then click **Continue**.
  - HMO: Select **HMO** under **Aetna Standard Plans** if you are interested in the Aetna HMO plan, then click **Continue**.
- If you live in all other states:
  - PPO or CDHP: Select **Managed Choice POS** under **Aetna Standard Plans**, then click **Continue**.
